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Consent for Quotient Testing

I understand that the QuotientTM is not a diagnostic instrument. Rather, it is intended to be **part** of my doctor's comprehensive evaluation for ADHD. The diagnostic process should also include a psychosocial and family history, parent & teacher checklists as well as other clinical information. The QuotientTM can be used to confirm an existing diagnosis and to monitor whether medication is optimized. I understand that Dr. Waxman is providing collateral information for my doctor and cannot determine whether my child has ADHD based solely on the results of the QuotientTM. I understand that in most cases, the results of the QuotientTM alone will not be sufficient for determining academic needs or accommodations. Schools and the College Board typically require a full psychoeducational evaluation before they approve accommodations. I agree that all test materials, results and reports are property of Dr. Waxman. I agree that if I am provided with a digital copy of Dr. Waxman's report, I am not permitted to make any changes to the report. I understand that it is my responsibility to inform Dr. Waxman if the parents are separated or divorced. In these cases, both parents are required to consent to the evaluation.

I acknowledge that Psychological Assessment is a complex task that requires information to be collected from a variety of sources and that information collected as part of the assessment process is confidential. Information is shared only with those who are authorized to have access.

Fees and Payment

The initial QuotientTM evaluation includes the initial administration of the computerized test, a report that is generated by the QuotientTM, a narrative and a feedback session. The QuotientTM is most beneficial when it is used serially to monitor progress and improvement of ADHD symptoms. Subsequent administrations include the computerized test, a QuotientTM report, and parent feedback comparing multiple tests. A copy of all reports will be sent to your doctor at your request. Often, the results of the QuotientTM raise questions about treatment goals and future directions for treatment.

There are times when parents will request that Dr. Waxman attend school meetings to discuss the results of the evaluation. This can be scheduled at a mutually agreeable time. This is not included in the testing fee. Dr. Waxman charges \$250.00 for attending a school meeting.
